There is also an Industry Advisory Board which include the main Pharmaceutical Companies involved in Ophthalmology Research.



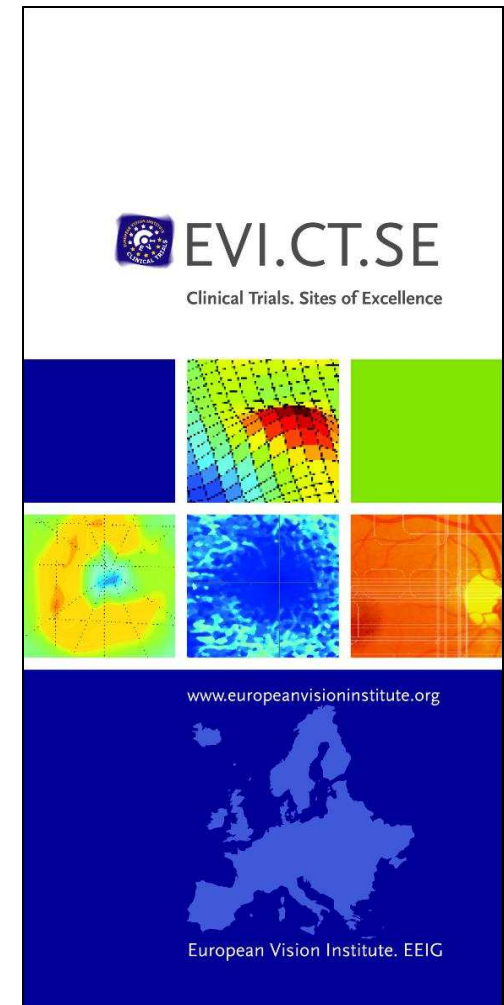
