The university hospital of Montpellier is seeking for an ophthalmologist to hold a permanent position in the national center of reference “inherited sensory diseases”. The center, which harbors top level equipment, has a 15-year history in inherited retinal dystrophies and provided clinical and molecular diagnosis for more than 900 families, in partnership with several local centers for rehabilitation and the “Institute for Neurosciences of Montpellier”, an INSERM laboratory working on sense organ pathophysiology and located on the same hospital campus. The applicant should have experience in clinical and molecular genetics and demonstrate a strong interest in research. The quality of his (her) past work, his (her) ability to interact in a team and to conduct phenotyping studies and clinical trials will be distinctive elements of the decision.
